C. Commission Reports:

1. Alumni –last met on Nov. 17. Memberships for 17/18 is 154, same as the previous year, transferred \$3,000 to school for scholarships.
2. Boosters: The income from turtles was \$59,318. The church portion was \$11,351.41 and the balance is for the Booster expenditures.
